

Priority areas for Healthy Schools Capital Fund investment

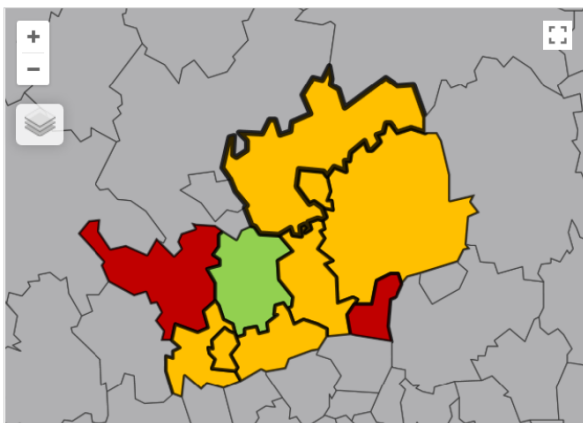

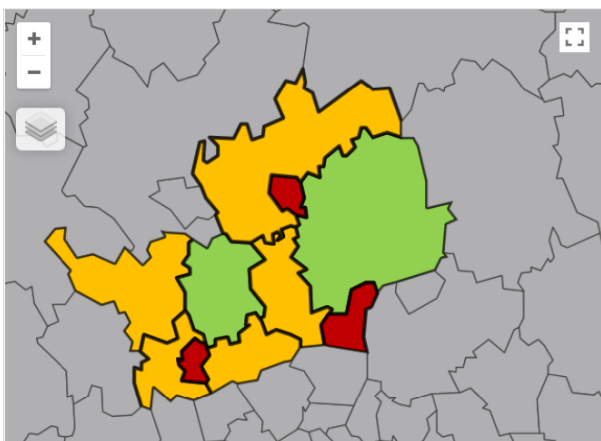
